

Transitions: (Between lessons, Before breaks)

How will students know to transition to the next lesson?

What is the volume level expectation during transition?

Where are lesson materials stored in the classroom?

How should students pack up the materials?

What will students need to be prepared for each lesson?

Where should complete/incomplete work be stored?

How long is the transition between lessons?

After the bell (Entering room, Attendance/Roll, Lunch choice, Daily Schedule)

How should students line up? Is there an order?

How can students solve disagreements when lining up?

How should students enter the room?

What is the expected noise level at the start of the day?

What materials will students need to be prepared?

How will attendance be taken?

Who takes the roll and notes to the office?

Where can the lunch order basket be found each day?

Who takes the lunch order basket to the canteen?

When should students read the daily visual schedule?

End of Day (Pack up, Clean Up, Papers to go home, Dismissal)

Will the students pack and stack at a specific time each day?

Where will students find notes for home and homework?

What specific areas in the classroom must be packed away?

How should the classroom look at the end of the day?

What happens if there is still equipment left out?

Will you assign a student to rate the clean up out of 10?

When can students put their school bags on their backs?

What must happen before students can be dismissed?

What happens when the bell rings?

Bathroom (Permission, hallway)

How should students ask to go to the toilet?

Will students need to take a pass?

Where can the toilet pass be found in the room?

Is there a non-verbal signal to ask permission to go to the

toilet when the teacher is busy?

What behaviour is expected in the school toilets?

Homework (Expectations, Missing, Late)

How do students know what the homework is each week?

Where do students find the homework in the classroom?

What will happen if homework is not handed up?

What stationery should be used in homework books?

How should homework be set out each week?

If students are absent, how will they get the homework?
