

Option #1 Teaching with a list

1. **Stop at the door:** Pause briefly before entering to get ready.
2. **Wait your turn:** If others are entering, wait quietly in line.
3. **Greet the teacher:** Say “Good morning” or another polite greeting.
4. **Enter quietly:** Walk in calmly without running or pushing.
5. **Go to your seat:** Find your assigned spot without distracting others.
6. **Prepare materials:** Take out your supplies silently and get ready for class.
7. **Sit quietly:** Stay seated and wait for instructions from the teacher.
8. **Begin the starter activity:** Start the warm-up task or bell work as directed.

Option #2 Teaching with a script

Classroom Entry Routine Script

Teacher:

“Okay class, let’s practice how to enter the classroom the right way. Listen carefully and watch me!”

1. **Stop at the door.**
“When you get to the door, pause for a moment to get ready.”
2. **Wait your turn.**
“If other students are entering, wait quietly in line without pushing.”
3. **Greet me.**
“When it’s your turn, say ‘Good morning’ or another greeting.”
4. **Enter quietly.**
“Walk calmly into the room—no running or loud noises.”
5. **Go to your seat.**
“Find your seat and sit down without disturbing anyone.”
6. **Prepare your materials.**
“Take out what you need quietly and get ready for class.”
7. **Sit quietly.**
“Stay in your seat and wait for my instructions.”
8. **Start the warm-up.**
“Begin the starter activity quietly when I say.”

Teacher:
